

# Other Things To Do...

## Need a day off the boards? There's plenty to do....

### [Chairlift Ride](#)

Use your valid lift pass or buy a special foot passenger ticket and head to the top of Thredbo where you can watch the passing parade of skiers and boarders while enjoying a snack at one of the mountain top cafes.

### [Self Guided Walks](#)

You can discover Thredbo at your own pace on foot with the four self guided walks around the village. The Art Walk takes in a diverse collection of outdoor sculptures and indoor paintings and etchings; the brochure has an explanation of the meaning of each work. The Heritage Walk shows you some of Thredbo's oldest and most interesting architectural works. The Memorial Walk takes you to several important spots around the village to give you an appreciation of the events that surrounded the 1997 road collapse. The Enviro Walk shows how Thredbo has managed its infrastructure with minimal impact on the environment. The free self guided brochures can be picked up from the Ticket Office in Valley Terminal.

### [Indulge Yourself](#)

### [Snow Shoe](#)

Snow shoeing is a great way for the non-skier or boarder to explore the spectacular scenery around Thredbo and the Main Range. You can take a guided snow shoe tour out to the summit of Mt Kosciusko, and they say if you can walk you can snow shoe! For tours contact Thredbo Outdoor Adventures at the Snow sports offices.

### [Wander Through the Village](#)

Take a walk around the Village Square and visit the assortment of shops and conveniences. The Village Square is the social focal point of Thredbo and you never know who you will bump into there. There's also something to delight everyone with gift shops, a home wares store, clothing boutiques and sportswear and outdoor gear, for your browsing pleasure. There's even a chemist, newsagency and supermarket for all your day to day needs, as well as video hire for those wanting to lounge in front of the TV on a cold winter's day or night.

### [Horse Riding](#)

Ride through the eucalypts and check out the views down the valley. Horse riding is available 15 minutes from Thredbo towards Jindabyne.

### [Enjoy a Long Lunch](#)

Take your pick from a diverse range of cafés, licensed bars and restaurants where you can sit down for a tasty meal to suit every budget and family, whether you want a casual BYO experience, quick bistro meal or a fine dining affair.

### [Gondola to Dinner](#)

For a dining experience at the top of Australia book for dinner at Eagle's Nest Restaurant. Gondolas replace the chairs on the Kosciusko Express and you are whisked to the top in an enclosed cabin taking in the lights and sights of the village below. (Weather permitting).

### [Thredbo Leisure Centre](#)

**Make a Splash** – swim a few leisurely laps in the 50 or 25 metre pool. There is also a spa pool to invigorate and rejuvenate those tired muscles.

**Workout** – if you still have energy to burn you can take in a session at the gym. You can pump iron, run, step, bike and row on the cardio machines and stretch on the mats.

**Climb** – the bouldering wall at the TLC is a great challenge and caters for beginners through to the more advanced.

**Ball Games** – in the indoor sports hall - have a kick of soccer, shoot some hoops, bat a ball, practice your goals or just throw the ball around.

**Squash** – for a competitive workout, whack a ball around the court with a mate.

**Waterslide** – for the kids (big kids too) the waterslide is open daily.

**Classes** – there are yoga, fit ball and aqua aerobics classes throughout the year.

**Mission Inflatable** – tackle the inflatable 16 metre obstacle course that floats over the 25 metre pool.

### [Tennis](#)

If the courts are clear of frost and snow you can have a hit on one of the four flood lit tennis courts available for hire. Tennis racquets are also available for hire through the Thredbo Ticket Office.

### [Relax](#)

Grab a book, sit by a roaring log fire and take in the fresh mountain air and views over snow covered slopes. The Lounge Bar in the Thredbo Alpine Hotel is the perfect place to kick back with the biggest fireplace in Thredbo.

### [Ride the Thredbo Bobsled](#)

Get a downhill thrill of a different kind on the 700 metre luge style bobsled. It winds down the mountain side with straights, snake bends, twists and turns. It's located next to the tennis courts and is open if weather permits.

### [Tie the Knot](#)

Thredbo is a beautiful place for a wedding year round. Choose a setting indoors at the Thredbo Chapel or outdoors by the duck ponds, on the 9<sup>th</sup> tee of the golf course or for a really big affair on the Village Green.
